

Through Christ Our Mediator

Romans 1:7-10

“For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all...” (1Tim.2:5-6)

The Separation Between God and Man

There is a great gulf between our thoughts and God's thoughts due to our human limitations (Job 23:3; Isa.55:8-9)

There is an even wider gulf between us and God due to His holiness and our sin and guilt (Rom.3:23; Isa.59:1-2)

For us to have knowledge of God and salvation from our sin, we need God's grace shown through Christ (Rom.1:5; 1Tim.1:14-15; Eph.2:18)

God has spoken to our ignorance through Christ and He has dealt with our sins through Christ (Heb.1:1-3)

God's Revelation Through Jesus Christ

God has spoken to us through His Son (Heb.1:1-2)

This revelation is made complete through Christ due to His deity and His humanity (Heb.1:2-3; 2:9-10,18,14; Phil.2:5-8)

We can fully know God through His Son (Jn.1:14; 14:9; 1Jn.5:20)

God's Redemption Through Jesus Christ

God has provided for our redemption through Christ who has “purged our sins” (Heb.1:3)

Jesus Christ, as our High Priest, “purged our sins” by the shedding of His own blood (Heb.9:11-15; Acts 13:38-39; 10:43)

Jesus is “Mediator of a better covenant” (Heb.8:6-12; 10:15-18)

Through Christ we have a finished sacrifice for sin (Heb.10:11-14)

Through Christ we can draw near to God (Heb.10:19-22; Eph.2:14-18)

Through Christ we can have assurance of our salvation (Rom.5:1-11)

Jesus said: “*I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*” (Jn.14:6)
