Acts 17:30-31



What Is Repentance?

- **Acts 2:36-38** Change in belief on sin and Christ
- **Acts 26:20** A turning; change in action
- **2 Cor. 7:10** Prompted by Godly sorrow
- Turning to God from a willful rejection or ignorance or disinterest

Importance of Repentance

- **2 Peter 3:9** It is His will for all man
- **Acts 17:30-31** It is commanded
- **Acts 2:38** Required for salvation
- **Luke 13:3,5** Without we will perish

Works Befitting Repentance

- **Luke 3:1-9** Repent and bear good fruit
- **Luke 3:10-18** They must change, turn
- **1 John 2:3** Assurance that we know Him
- **2 Cor. 5:17** New creation = New things
- **We must change, no longer living in the flesh!**
